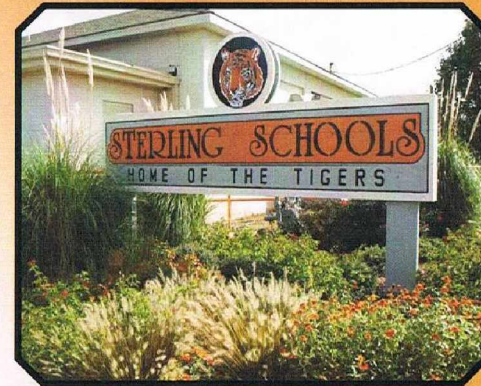

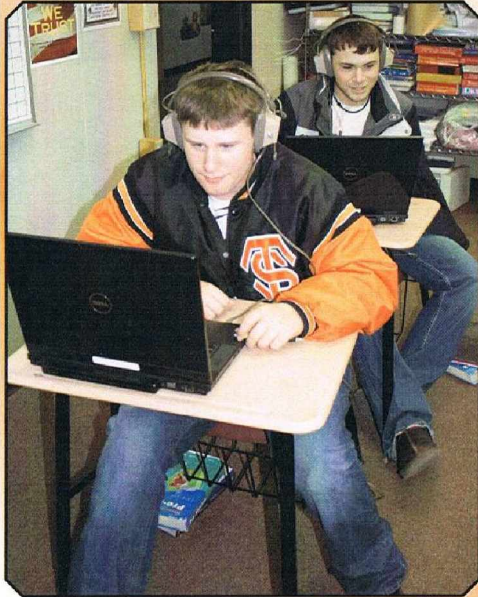


HOME OF THE TIGER

ACADEMICS

Sterling Public Schools provides extensive individual instruction by offering a 12 to 1 student/teacher ratio. Secondary class courses are

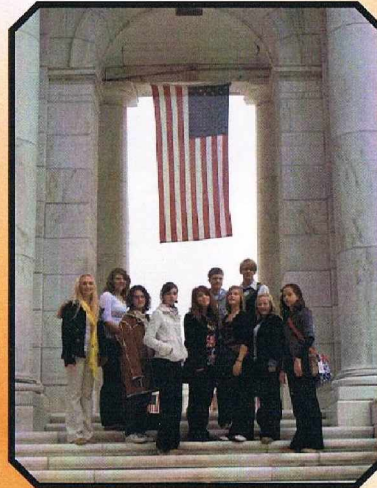


Learning math in the math computer lab.

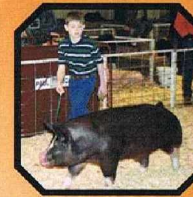
